 - moving away from the **old placement-based funding system** and replacing it with an **intensity-of-services funding model**
 - **\$1,000 for every Full Individual and Initial Evaluation (FIIE)** completed
 - **Additional Supports** HB 2 also:
 - o Increases College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) outcomes bonuses for students receiving special education services from \$2,000 to \$4,000.
 - o Increases transportation funding for special education students.
 - o Create grants to increase the number of qualified special education teachers, diagnosticians, related service providers, and paraprofessionals
